

EYFS Phonics/Reading Activities

Date: 29.06.20 **Focus:** Guided Reading-Scarecrow letter Phonics-

All of these activities will be taught in school-phonics on both days they are in and Guided Reading on both days they are in. If you are continuing to home school your child then you can do all 4 activities at home.

Lesson	Activity	Guidance for Parents
1	<p>Guided reading- This will follow the same format every week and it is one the children are familiar with.</p> <p>There is a letter from a Scarecrow attached. You are going to read this with a grown up.</p>	<p>*Talk to the children about the format. Is it a poem? A story? Can they identify that this is a letter?</p> <p>*The children love 'Echo' reading. You read a line to them and they copy you. They really enjoy it when you use funny voices.</p>
2	<p>Guided Reading</p> <p>Share the letter again. Can you remember why the scarecrow wanted your help?</p>	<p>Questions that you can ask your child about the letter.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> *What is the scarecrow called? *Where does the scarecrow live? *What is the scarecrows job? *Why are there not many vegetables left? *Can you think of something he could make to feed the birds? *Have you ever written a letter? Who did you write it to?
3	<p>These are our new blends this week.</p> <p>Can you say the blend?</p> <p>Can you think of other words with the same blends at the beginning?.</p> <p>Have a look around the room, what can you find?</p>	<p>Encourage your child to work out the blend, can they think of other words with the sounds, mix them up with other blends we have been looking at- can they find the new ones?</p>
4	<p>Can you remember our new blends this week?</p> <p>We are going to play a game on Phonics Play called - buried treasure.</p> <p>This is a fun game where you can read the words and decide if they are real or fake.</p>	<p>Phonics play- you can log on and it is free to play. If you can't access it- write out some of the words we have been practising and make up some words- see if your child can recognise them. 😊</p>
